Dear Property Owner:

Portions of the sidewalk adjacent to your property have been included for replacement in the 2025 Sidewalk Replacement Program. The City of Sterling Heights Sidewalk Replacement Program provides for improved sidewalk conditions and increased pedestrian safety for all sidewalk users. The City has hired Luigi Ferdinandi and Sons Cement Co. to complete the program.

Over the coming weeks, City personnel will place paint marks on the sidewalk needing replacement. The replacement will be completed as the contractor circulates through the City. The program is anticipated to begin in June and conclude in September 2025.

On November 5, 2024 a ballot proposal for the Pathways to Play and Preservation (PPP) Milage was approved by voters providing a funding source for this sidewalk repair. As a result of this proposal, the cost of the sidewalk replacement will be funded by the City and you will not receive any bill or invoice for the work.
